FITTING INSTRUCTIONS Suits: Honda Civic EF-EJ / CRX / Integra


NOTE: OE BUSH IS TAPERED – PRESS OUT ONE WAY

N.B: These instructions should be used in conjunction with workshop manual.

- 1. Raise the rear of the vehicle and support on chassis stands, remove the wheels.
- 2. Disconnect the brake hose from the rear brakes and plug to prevent leakage.
- 3. Detach the upper, lower control arm and compensator arm from the trailing arm.
- Disconnect the parking brake cable bracket from the trailing arm.
- Undo the bolts securing the trailing arm to the chassis and remove the trailing arm from the vehicle.
- Remove the entire original pivot bush from the trailing arm and discard.
- Inspect the arm for damage, bent, pitted or worn components and replace as necessary.
- Note the supplied steel pin is already pressed into the bushing the shorter end of the pin should be facing the outside of the vehicle once installed.
- Install the new replacement tapered shell bushes with the small side of the tapered shell to the inside of the vehicle.
- 10. Installation is the reverse

NOTE: Tighten all components AT NORMAL ROAD HEIGHT to manufacturers specifications and bleed the brakes if required.

11. A 4 wheel alignment should be performed after fitment.
